



HHGS Environmental Policy

§1 This environmental policy applies to all activities within the Student Union of the School of Business, Economics and Law (HHGS).

§2 HHGS strives for the least possible environmental impact and our goal is to constantly improve our environmental performance.

§3 HHGS shall comply with the laws and requirements that apply to our business.

§4 When purchasing food, office supplies and other goods, consideration must be given to the environment. Environmentally sound and fair-labeled products should be chosen when it is economically justifiable.

§5 The HHGS board shall endeavor to attain appropriate knowledge in how to run a sustainable organisation.

§6 When traveling representing HHGS the trip should be made in an environmentally sound and cost effective manner.

§7 HHGS shall annually arrange a conference for its members where sustainability must be one of the standing point on the agenda.

§8 HHGS shall take an active part in environmental work at the School of Business, Economics and Law including participation in or contributing to the networks and events that are organized and provide ideas on how the work can be improved. HHGS also aims to ensure that the education at the School of Business, Economics and Law has elements of sustainable development and that this is included in the marketing of the School. HHGS should set a good example in this regard.
