The student Union Board decides to approve GADDEN's budget.

The Student Union Board decides to approve the invoice for GADDEN's artist.

The Student Union Board has approved the invoice for GADDEN's banquet per capsulam.

The Student Union Board has approved JF's budget per capsulam.

N&FA's van has been damaged during the initiation weeks and the project group has asked The Student Union Board to decide how much of the cost they can take from the project's budget and how much should be paid by the project group members privately. Several alternative distributions are discussed, ranging from the entire cost going to the budget to only 50% being covered by the budget. The Student Union Board concludes that damages to a car used in the association's activities should be treated as how a damage to the student union car would have been treated. For the union car, HHGS has a policy that says that 60% of the cost goes to the budget and the rest can be paid privately. The Student Union Board decides to follow the policy and therefore let N&FA take 60% of the cost of the damage on the project's budget.

Those who did not attend the strategy weekend receive an update on what was discussed. What we mainly take with us is that a workshop based on our strengths, weaknesses and how we function as people will be held, so that we can get to know each other better. In addition, many have requested more social events where we socialize as a group. Regarding the project groups, it's time for new efforts. The Student Union Board has created two groups that will visit the new bachelor and master classes during the fall semester and present the Union as part of the inclusion work. A workshop will also be arranged for the associations regarding inclusion and internationalization.

In IntU's case, it costs as much to choose vegetarian as to choose meat or fish. The Student Union Board decides that it is OK for them to take fish if it is good and sustainable.
