Welcome Weeks was a major discussion point for the trip. In Stockholm, Welcome Weeks is a project and the Student Union Board is discussing whether the same arrangement would work here. Mental health was also discussed on the trip. The union in Stockholm has an app to prevent mental illness, where students can participate in workshops and the like.
